

Administrative Council Meeting

May 18, 2011

Shane Truitt called the meeting to order at 6P.M. He opened with a prayer & scripture reading of John 14: 1-7. Betty Vancil gave a devotional from Bishop Schnase book, "The Balancing Act". Why we do, what we do (Vestige). 2 Corinthians 5: 17 says when we become a Christian, we become a brand new person. A new life has begun.

Those in attendance were: Bobby Truitt, Betty Vancil, Dr Julie Burdin, Shane Truitt, Karen Butner, Jo Vaughn Kelly, Mark Truitt, Bobbi Jo Lucas & Rhonda Linsley.

The minutes of the last meeting were presented. Mark Truitt motioned to approve as presented, Karen Butner 2nd. Motion passed.

The Treasurers report was presented. Bobbi Jo reported the loan is paid off, apportionments are paid to date and our financials are looking good. She also reported the Love offering for the Ketsenburg's was well received. There was an error in QuickBooks when she made the direct deposit & it overpaid by \$600.00. She asked for direction on what should be done, Bobby Truitt motioned to correct the error and Jo Vaughn seconded. Motion passed. Karen Butner motioned we approve the minutes as presented, Rhonda Linsley 2nd. Motion passed.

The Serving Team report was submitted. Dr Burdin commented on the Family Fun Fest. There is a bulletin board in the Multi Purpose for anyone who would like to help to sign up. Serving Saturday was a huge success. Cardwell Lumber supplied all the mulch at about 1/3 the cost. There are still 2 spots left for the mission trip to Frakes, Ky. The Serving team has paid for 15 and have 13 committed. The cost per person is \$210.00; all but \$50.00 is being paid by Serving Team.

The Sharing Team report was submitted. Jo Vaughn commented on the magnets they had ordered. We will be the only church featured on the magnet.

The Children's Ministry report was submitted. Rhonda is working hard on Vacation Bible School. If anyone would be interested in picking up kids, who otherwise would not have transportation, please let Rhonda know.

The Youth Ministry report was submitted. Karen wanted it recorded in minutes that Caleb Butner will be attending the National Worship Leaders Conference in Leawood, Ks hosted by the Church of the Resurrection in July at a cost of \$200.00 which he paid himself. Dr Burdin made the motion to re-

imburse Caleb \$100.00 out of the General operating account, seconded by Bobby Truitt. Motion passed. Karen also wanted to note that the youth praise band will not play during worship service in June. They will play the 3rd Sunday in July.

Mark Truitt reported that SPRC had met and come up with a better system for checks & balances for the Staff. Formal evaluations forms have been drafted and will be implemented the end of June. He also reported they are starting to advertise for a Nursery attendant as Kari Truitt will be leaving in August for college.

Bobby Truitt reported for the Trustee's in Sherwin Dent's absence. We are still having problems with the roof leaking. We have not been successful in getting Jamie Seaton to respond to our problem. A letter has been sent from our attorney, Meisner & Burks LLC, giving him 30 days or we will take further action. Sherwin asked the Methodist Men for help in filling the cracks & sealing the West parking lot at an approximate cost of \$850.00 versus \$4500.00 that it cost us in 2008. We would hire a professional to do the stripping. The Methodist Men agreed to help & pay \$200.00 toward the cost. The sidewalk in front of the church will be replaced this summer through the city sidewalk replacement program at 50% of the cost.

Other Business: Shane Truitt suggested that we send cards, to those that we know are hurting, from our group as leaders of the church. We signed 4 cards tonight. Bobbi Jo suggested that maybe we are not as attentive to our own church family as we should be. We all need to be more diligent in our caring & compassion for our flock. Mark Truitt motioned we adjourn, Jo Vaughn 2nd. Motion passed. Dr Julie Burdin closed in prayer at 8:45p.m.
